III. Project, Standing Committee, Commission and Liaison Reports

- A. Glenville Wolf Hollow Project Alex Lykins
 - still acquiring land... This will be the first new preserve in the county since the 80s!
- B. CSC Task Force Updates Alec Lykins
 - The county submitted an application to the DEC. They purposely overshot on points in hopes of getting silver, but haven't heard back from the DEC yet.
 - This is an ongoing process, and once they receive certification they will continue this great work.
- C. Pesticide Policy Update Alex Lykins
 - Do we know of a list of acceptable pesticide products?
 - And/or should we create a waiver process for when applying a pesticide is necessary?
 - SCEAC could be the reviewing body for these requests (perhaps a subcommittee)
 - Next step: put the resolution on the floor for SCEAC to pass for the next meeting
- D. Follow up on Skip the Stuff (STS) Campaign Portia Zwicker
 - Should it be a law or a resolution? Local laws are generally brought forth by Rich and Sarah Mae, so they would need to be on board with this.
 - We would need to drum up local support (esp. business owners & local organizations) for this law.
 - A resolution could bring better awareness to the issue to start (and would be a statement of SCEACs position on the issue)
 - Who would enforce it? In Albany it's the DOH. The head of Schenectady DOH is an ex-officio member, so we could reach out to see the level of support.
 - Next steps: draft STS resolution; contact Schenectady head of DOH
